Code of Conduct

As a parent, coach, volunteer, and/or fan of the Marion Walker Little League:

- 1) I will not force children to play Little League Baseball.
- 2) I will remember that children play to have fun, and that the game is for kids, not adults.
- 3) I will learn the rules of the game and policies of the MWLL.
- 4) I (and my guests) will be positive role models by displaying proper sportsmanship at all practices and games.
- 5) I will not encourage any strategies or practices which would endanger the health or well- being of an athlete.
- 6) I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning so that my child will never feel defeated by his/her individual performance(s).
- 7) I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other teammates for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- 8) I will praise all participants for trying and make my child feel like a winner each time.
- 9) I will promote the emotional and physical well-being of participants ahead of any personal desire or motive of my own.
- 10) I will respect all umpires and will not engage in any unsportsmanlike dialogue with them. I further understand that the umpire's decision is final.
- 11) I will realize that at this level greater importance should be placed upon skill development than on winning games.
- 12) I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol. As such, I will also refrain from their use at all league events.
- 13) I will refrain from coaching my child at practices and at games unless I am one of the official coaches of the team.
